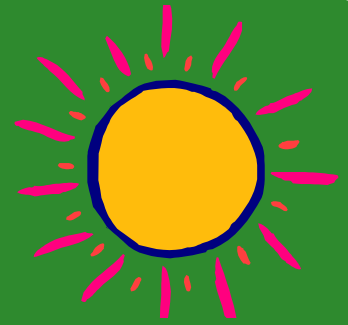

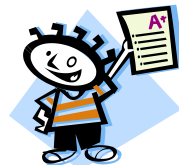

Kansas Wax Museum

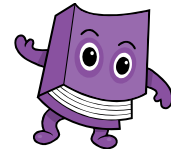
