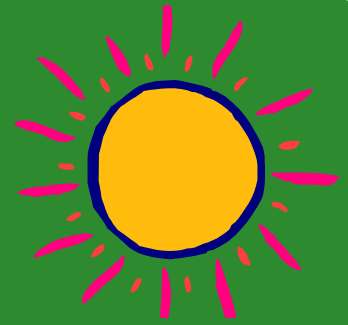

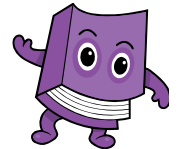


## **HOMWORK!!**
