Reading Group:

Please continue to work on the list of sight words that were sent home.

Thank you for working with your child each evening!

Classroom:

Please continue to work at home on sight words. Students will encounter these words frequently in reading and writing. It is critical that readers and writers develop automatic recognition of sight words. Students need to read sight words instantly and without hesitation. Thank you for working with your child at home.

Reading Group:

We have seen a lot of growth since Christmas and are excited to share at conferences. We are continuing to work on rhyming and blending words together.

Please practice your word wall words and letters every night while reading.

Classroom:

Please have your child share the fun and exciting things they do throughout the day with you. We will be focusing on being helpful and kind to others this month. Remember, if your conference time does not work please let me know so that we can reschedule a time that is more convenient for you.

Reading Group:

We are working on:
*rhyming and syllables in reading. *Say a word and ask your student to give you a rhyming word. *Practice breaking words up into parts to work on syllables (ta - ble). *Another way to practice syllables is to have children "delete" a syllable (ask them what sunshine has left if you take away the sun).

Classroom:

Just a few reminders: - please practice letters, sounds, sight words and counting to 100 each night -read with your child each day (don't forget to color in the day on the reading log) -make sure that your child's name is on their jackets and coats.

Reading Group:

We are on the right track! We are sounding out words (cat= c-a-t). Remember to read every night and practice sight words! After reading, talk about the book (What was it about? What was your favorite part?)
